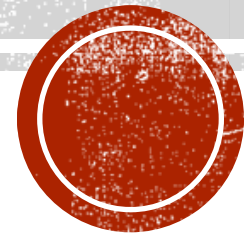

# GENERAL CONCEPT

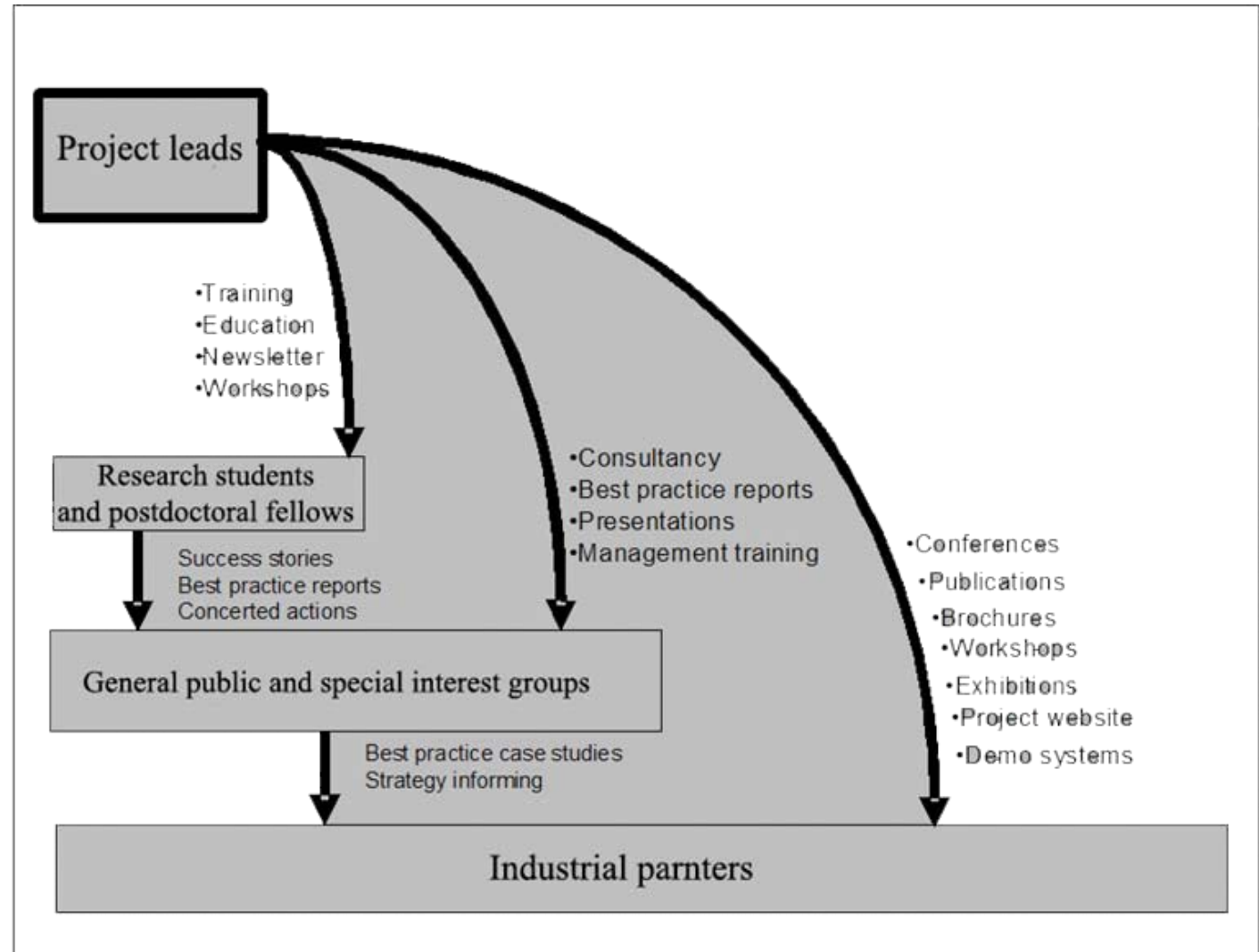
- CDPE deployed a variety of dissemination strategies based upon the basal instruction line of the Project's Coordinator.
